



The MCHA's Housing Choice Voucher Program (HCVP) to Accept applications Online from November 15 – 21, 2024.

The Montgomery County Housing Authority is scheduled to accept online applications for our HCVP waiting list (formerly known as Section 8) 24 hours a day beginning Friday, November 15th, at 12:01am and ending at 11:59pm on Thursday, November 21st. Please note, the MCHA **will only accept applications submitted online** at www.montcoha.org.

Also please note, **this will NOT be first-come, first-served**. All applications submitted online will have the same opportunity of receiving a voucher via a lottery system. Up to 1,000 applicants will be selected at random using computer software and placed on the HCVP waiting list.

For applicants that do not have Internet access, all public libraries in Montgomery County provide Internet access to the public. MCHA Staff will provide assistance in submitting applications online at the following times and locations:

Friday, November 15th (10am through 1pm)
Saturday, November 16th (10am through 1pm)
Monday, November 18th (2pm through 7pm)

Additionally, the MCHA's office at 104 W. Main Street, Norristown, PA 19401 will provide internet access during normal business hours. **Applicants may use any computer/mobile device to submit their application. Applicants are not required to visit any of the above locations to apply*. Applying is FREE of charge and no applicant should pay a fee to apply.**

* Persons with disabilities requiring a reasonable accommodation to apply must contact 484-801-0436 (or PA Voice Relay 800-654-5988) no later than 3:00pm on November 21st or submit a written request to the MCHA. Any written request must be received by the MCHA or postmarked no later than November 21st, 2024.
